Supply & installation of doors x 3 £5718 inc VAT
Supply & installation of windows £8899 inc VAT

Total cost £14,617 inc VAT

#### Quotes valid for 1 month.

Preferred supplier is DL Windows but the work is urgent and if DL cannot deliver this in time we may have to go with D'Arcy Lawes. Therefore a mid cost of £14,700 included in grant applications

#### Project management

In order to maintain income and avoid losing hirers to other venues the hall will need to remain open to users as usual during the course of the window and door replacement.

This will require the two volunteers who usually work at the hall to be present during the duration of the work in order to: continue to support hall users and clubs, liaise with window company and users, unlock, set up safe areas for users, manage health and safety, regular wiping down and sweeping, secure the premises etc.

## Cleaning

The work is extensive and will by necessity create additional dust and dirt – requiring daily cleaning and a final deep clean. (Usually the hall is cleaned weekly).

#### Making good and redecoration

Work will also be required to make good and repaint damaged plasterwork at the end of the project. The plasterwork around the doors and windows is very old and friable but the amount of repair work needed will not be known until the installation is completed.

The sum quoted is an estimate and should allow for some plastering and purchase of paint for volunteers to redecorate.
