9. For what purpose or project is the grant requested? *

Community First Responders are volunteers attend 999 calls for the ambulance service, ahead of the paramedics, arriving first on scene. The jobs we go to can include cardiac arrests, seizures, strokes, breathing difficulties and falls. We are raising funds for a new pulse oximeter which will be able to be used on all patients from new born babies to the elderly. This equipment tells us the patient's oxygen levels and heart rate and informs part of the primary survey, helping to decide if the call needs to upgraded to urgent, helping patients obtain prompt help if needed and early diagnosis of medical conditions such as sepsis. At this current time we are not able to take observations on children as our current pulse oximeter is for adults, the new one will include a child one as well for birth upwards. This is to be used in the Lyneham kit. All upkeep and maintenance of the equipment donated cost is met by the South Western Ambulance Service Trust. This equipment sees hundreds of patients every year and will last 10-15 years, possibly more in service.
